

Reflections from the New Evangelization Summit

The Gospel of St. Matthew today recalls Jesus sending his apostles to *"make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."* Jesus entrusts this command in every time to the Church, who inherited from the Apostles this missionary mandate.

This missionary mandate was so powerfully expressed through the 9 inspirational Catholic speakers who presented at last month's New Evangelization Summit.

The Good News of salvation is the fundamental message of the Church. This message is first proclaimed in the Gospels themselves where we are told to repent and believe the Good News. On the lips of courageous saints and heroic missionaries, the same words have echoed for millennia. Today, WE are invited to be the instruments of God in bearing this Good News to a world that so desperately needs to hear a joyful message of hope in a Saviour.

A group of parishioners who attended the weekend conference came together to talk about our primary 'take-aways' and how to implement what we learned:

- Evangelization is first about personally having a relationship with Jesus, and sharing the joy of that relationship. This relationship and the joy the results is essential first. This is the driver and motivator. *"...let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross..."* (Hebrews 12: 1-2)
- We need to be rooted in our need for Him (rooted in Scripture) and rely on the power of the Holy Spirit. Ultimately, it is the Spirit who does the work of conversion; all we do is accompany and that frees us from becoming discouraged when we don't see immediate conversions.
- Who am I called to accompany right now? Evangelization is relational - that is, it is most effective one-on-one and therefore only happens when trust is formed/earned. It is not big programs that convert people. For example, Alpha is an effective tool for evangelization but people still need community and someone to "accompany"



them on their lifelong journey to the heart of Christ.

- Spiritual multiplication happens when one person evangelizes another, then both each reach out to 2 more; then the 4 each reach out to 4 more... etc.
- We need to each work on our 'story' - the moment when you decided to orient your life to Christ. Your story is unique and is an authentic witness to the fact that He is real, He is active!
- Therefore, we need to learn how to accompany each other on our faith journey. Accompaniment is about leading others ever closer to the heart of God. In this way, we can *"make present the fragrance of Christ's closeness and his personal gaze... this 'art of accompaniment' teaches us to remove our sandals before the sacred ground of the other"* (*The Joy of the Gospel*, 169)
- To accompany another on the journey of faith requires first and foremost that our own hearts be in Christ... because how can we accompany someone else to accept God's desire for them if we ourselves are not reflecting God's desire for us in our own lives?

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, which leads us to contemplate and worship the divine life of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit: a life of communion and perfect love, origin and aim of all the universe and of every creature: God. We also recognize in the Trinity the model for the Church, in which **we are called to love each other as Jesus loved us. And love is the concrete sign that demonstrates faith in God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.** And love is the badge of the Christian, as Jesus told us: *"By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another"* (John 13:35). It's a contradiction to think of Christians who hate. It's a contradiction. And the devil always seeks this: to make us hate, because he's always a troublemaker; he doesn't know love; God is love!

We are all called to witness and proclaim the message that "God is love", that God isn't far and insensitive to our human affairs. He is close to us, always beside us, walking with us to share our joys and our sorrows, our hopes and our struggles. He loves us very much and for that reason he became man, he came into the world not to condemn it, but so the world would be saved through Jesus. And this is the love of God in Jesus, this love that is so difficult to understand but that we feel when we draw close to Jesus. And he always forgives us, he always awaits us, he loves us so much. And we feel the love of Jesus and the love of God.

The Holy Spirit, gift of the Risen Jesus, conveys divine life to us and thus lets us enter into the dynamism of the Trinity, which is a dynamism of love, of communion, of mutual service, of sharing. A person who loves others for the very joy of love is a reflection of the Trinity. A family in which each person loves and helps one another is a reflection of the Trinity. A parish in which each person loves and shares spiritual and material effects is a reflection of the Trinity.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity renews the Christian mission of living in communion with God and others. This means to receive and accordingly give witness to the beauty of the Gospel. To live in love mutually and towards all, sharing in joy and sufferings, learning to ask and to grant forgiveness, valuing the various charisms under the guidance of the Pastors.




