

Dear Parishioners,

The Church now enters into a brief period of Ordinary weeks in the liturgical cycle, in between the celebration of the Christmas season and the Lenten season. So we wear the green vestments and begin to hear the preaching of Jesus as he begins his earthly ministry. Dear Brothers and Sisters... Today we focus on the first of the miracles of Jesus, which the evangelist John calls "signs", because Jesus did not do them to arouse wonder, but to **reveal the love of the Father**. The first of these prodigious signs is told by John and is performed at Cana in Galilee. It is a sort of "gateway", in which words and expressions are engraved that illuminate the entire mystery of Christ and open the disciples' heart to faith.

In the introduction we find the expression *"Jesus with his disciples"*(v.2). Those who Jesus called to follow him bound them to himself in a community and now, as one family, they are all invited to the wedding. Opening his public ministry at the wedding of Cana, Jesus manifests himself as the spouse of the people of God, announced by the prophets, and **reveals to us the depth of the relationship that unites us to him: it is a new covenant of love**.

What is the foundation of our faith? An act of mercy with which Jesus has bound us to himself. And Christian life is the answer to this love, it is like the story of two lovers. **God and man meet, seek, find, celebrate and love each other:** just like the beloved and the beloved in the Song of Songs. **Everything else comes as a result of this relationship. The Church is the family of Jesus in which his love pours out; it is this love that the Church guards and wants to give to everyone.**

In the context of the Alliance we also include the observation of Our Lady: *"They have no wine"* (v. 3). How you can celebrate the wedding and party it lacks what the prophets indicated as a typical feature of the Messianic banquet? Water is necessary for living, but the wine expresses the abundance of the banquet and the joy of the party. It is a wedding party in which wine is missing; the newlyweds feel ashamed of this. But imagine you finish a wedding party by drinking tea; it would be a shame. Wine is necessary for the party. By turning the water of the stone jars used *"for the ritual purification of the Jews"*(v. 6) into wine, Jesus makes an eloquent sign: **he transforms the Law of Moses into the Gospel** i.e. Jesus is replacing that old model with something new. It is compelling and beautiful. He

confronts often this idea of clean and unclean. In fact time and time again, Jesus saves his harshest judgment for those who are ethically about moral cleanliness rather than inward transformation. Jesus is saying, *That day is over, and there's a new day that has come, and that new day is I've brought good wine. I've brought celebration and joy and rejoicing, because I have cleansed you. I will make you new. I will wash away your stains...* Jesus, because he knows this is hard for us, throughout his entire ministry shows this to us to be true. As John himself says elsewhere: *"The Law was given through Moses, grace and truth came through Jesus Christ"* (John 1:17).

The words that Mary addresses to the servants come to crown the spousal framework of Cana: *"Whatever he tells you, do it"* (v. 5). It is curious that these are her last words reported by the Gospels; they are her legacy that she gives to all of us. Even today, our Lady tells us all: **Whatever Jesus tells you - do it.**

In this marriage, a New Covenant is truly stipulated and the new mission is entrusted to the servants of the Lord, that is to the whole Church: *"Whatever you say, do it!"* To serve the Lord means to listen and put his Word into practice. It is the simple but essential recommendation of the Mother of Jesus and is the Christian's life program. For each of us, to draw from the amphora (tall jars) is equivalent to trusting the Word of God to experience its effectiveness in life. So, together with the head of the banquet who tasted the water turned into wine, we can also exclaim: *"You have kept good wine aside until now"* (v. 10). Yes, the Lord continues to reserve that good wine for our salvation, just as it continues to flow from the pierced side of the Lord.

The conclusion of the story sounds like a sentence: *"This, at Cana in Galilee, was the beginning of the signs made by Jesus; he manifested his glory and his disciples believed in him"*(v. 11). The wedding at Cana is much more than the simple story of Jesus' first miracle. Like a casket, he keeps the secret of his person and the purpose of his coming: the awaited Spouse initiates the wedding that takes place in the Paschal Mystery. **In this wedding Jesus binds his disciples to himself with a new and definitive Covenant.** At Cana the disciples of Jesus become his family and at Cana the faith of the Church is born. **We are invited to those weddings, because new wine is no longer lacking!**




