

Pastor's Corner

Dear Parishioners,

The season of Lent begins this week with the Ash Wednesday Masses, and we are reminded that it is a universal day of fast and abstinence for the adult members of the Church. The Gospel text will challenge us with the teachings of Jesus on prayer, fasting, and alms giving, and so we need to consider what we're going to do to enrich our faith by the Lenten practices we decide to take upon ourselves. Traditionally we might give up something, or do a work of piety or charity, or maybe dedicate some time to the adoration chapel or to some added spiritual reading. Those families with children at home might also decide to do something as a family, helping the young to contribute to their own holiness of life and that of their family, for the six weeks of the Lenten season.

The fruit of our Lenten practices takes on a charitable focus when we come to the 5th Sunday of Lent, called "Share Lent Sunday," and take up a second collection in support of the work of the Church in the developing countries of the world. This is channelled through Caritas Canada, and our Development and Peace Office provides us with materials that highlight their good work. We have included a bulletin insert for this weekend that gives you both a calendar for Lent with daily reflections and the contact information for your personal use at home. The Lenten colour is purple and the overall character for this 6 week journey is one of somber reflection and penitential attitude. We tone down on the parties and festivities of life and try to be more resistant to the temptations of selfish behavior in order to be more generous with those in need and our call to give alms to the poor. And at the same time we are supposed to be joyful and peaceful in everything we do. So let's pray for a happy Lent.

This Sunday's Mass Readings

Archbishop Folio - "Who has a Pure Heart is not Blind"
FEB 28, 2019 zenith.org

Today's Gospel offers us the final verses of the discourse Jesus was making in the plain near the Lake of Galilee. In last Sunday's Gospel, the Son of God invited us to be merciful like the heavenly Father: not to judge, not to condemn, to absolve and to give without measure.

Then, as it is today, Christ invites us to live the Beatitudes in our lives. **The fundamental truth of living the Christian life is this: a joyful moral life is the consequence of an encounter with the Living God and belonging to Him, not a sterile moralism** (i.e. checklist mentality of good actions vs. bad actions). Jesus asks us to be merciful because the Father is merciful; **our merciful actions that flow from obedience to God then are the consequence of the encounter we have had with Jesus, the Redeemer.**

In today's verses in Luke, Jesus continues his teaching on mercy with parables; the first of which is the shortest parable in the Bible: "*Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?*" (Luke 6:39). It is directed at the Scribes and Pharisees and those in the community who think that they are the holders of the truth and therefore superior to others and do not practice mercy. It is very simple: If a blind man leads a blind man, eventually both of them are doomed. The most consistent accusation that the Pharisees make against Jesus is that He's a glutton, and a drunkard and a friend of sinners. The most consistent accusation made by Jesus on the Pharisees is that **they are blind**. This is why they are blind: they do not possess the truth – they are spiritually blind. Those who think that there is a way superior to mercy is a blind man! What happens to those who want to try ways superior to those of God? He falls into the pit of death because **there is no life far from God's mercy**. Wanting to lead others may seem like a gesture of love, but when you are blind and you claim to be a guide, it is not true love, it is pure selfishness that leads into the ravine.

In verse 40, Christ continues his speech by saying: "*No disciple is superior to the teacher...*". Jesus is affirming: If someone thinks he is doing something better than what I did, I who am the Master. He is mistaken because to be a good Christian disciple, **it is enough just to be like him: humble operators of mercy**. The presumption, among other things, is a sign of stupidity.

And who are the bad teachers? Verses 41 and 42 tell us: "*Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye,*

but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? ... You hypocrite! Remove the wooden beam from your eye first; then you will see clearly to remove the splinter in your brother's eye." The bad teachers are those blind to mercy; they are the presumptuous ones who are ruthless judges with the others while expecting mercy and kindness only for themselves (i.e. hypocrite); they look at all the *straws* in the eyes of others but do not realize they have a *beam* in the eye. **The one who looks only for the straws in the eyes of others is dead in the heart.**

In the parable of the straw in the eye of his brother, **Jesus asks us for an attitude that makes us able to meet the other with total openness to relate to God with the trust of children**. Therefore we judge not to punish, but to share, to correct with love and with mercy, and to stand with - **fraternally to go to Christ and graft ourselves to Him**, the tree of life.

There is the hypocrisy of sinners.. and there is the '**hypocrisy of the just**' which is the fear of the love of Jesus ~ the fear of allowing ourselves to love. And in reality, when we do this, we try to take control of our relationship with Jesus. We tell Him: "Yes, I go to Mass, but afterwards You stay in the Church while I go home." And Jesus does not come home with us, does not come into our families, into the education of our children, into our school, into our neighbourhood.

We pretend to have Jesus, but cast Him aside. And so Jesus remains in the Church or on the crucifix or a holy card.

Today is the day for us to make an examination of conscience: Is Jesus saying this to you: 'Woe to you, woe to you, because I have given you so much, I have given you Myself, I have chosen you to be Christian, and you prefer a life by halves, a superficial life: a little bit of Christianity and holy water, but nothing more.' **Is Jesus saying this to you?**

When this kind of Christian hypocrisy is lived, what we end up doing is casting Jesus from our hearts. We pretend to have Him, but we have cast him out. 'We are Christians', we say. 'We are proud to be Christians.' But we live like pagans. Some of us live our Christianity as a 'social habit', in a purely formal manner. And when Mass is over, we leave Jesus in the Church; He does come with us when we return home, or in our daily lives. **Is this you?**



In Canada, the Church prescribes fasting and abstinence on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Catholics aged 18-59 are bound to fast; those 14 and older to abstinence.

Fasting = only one full meal and two smaller meals which together are not greater than a full meal.

Abstinence = from meat and/or other desirable foods.

Those who are ill are freed from these obligations. Everyone, even those above the age of 59, are encouraged to fast and abstain. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance.

S.29 of Canada's liturgical calendar specifies that Fridays are special days of abstinence. This includes Fridays of Lent, although Catholics can substitute special acts of charity or piety on these days.



2nd Collection for St. Joseph's Society Next Weekend - March 9 & 10

This collection is a way of helping the Church carry out its responsibility to provide for retired and sick priests. The Society provides benefits and is like a pension plan that complements CPP. The Society also provides assistance to priests who are sick as well as priests who are semi-retired to supplement their income. The collection is an opportunity for the people of the diocese to express their appreciation for the years of service retired priests have given.




