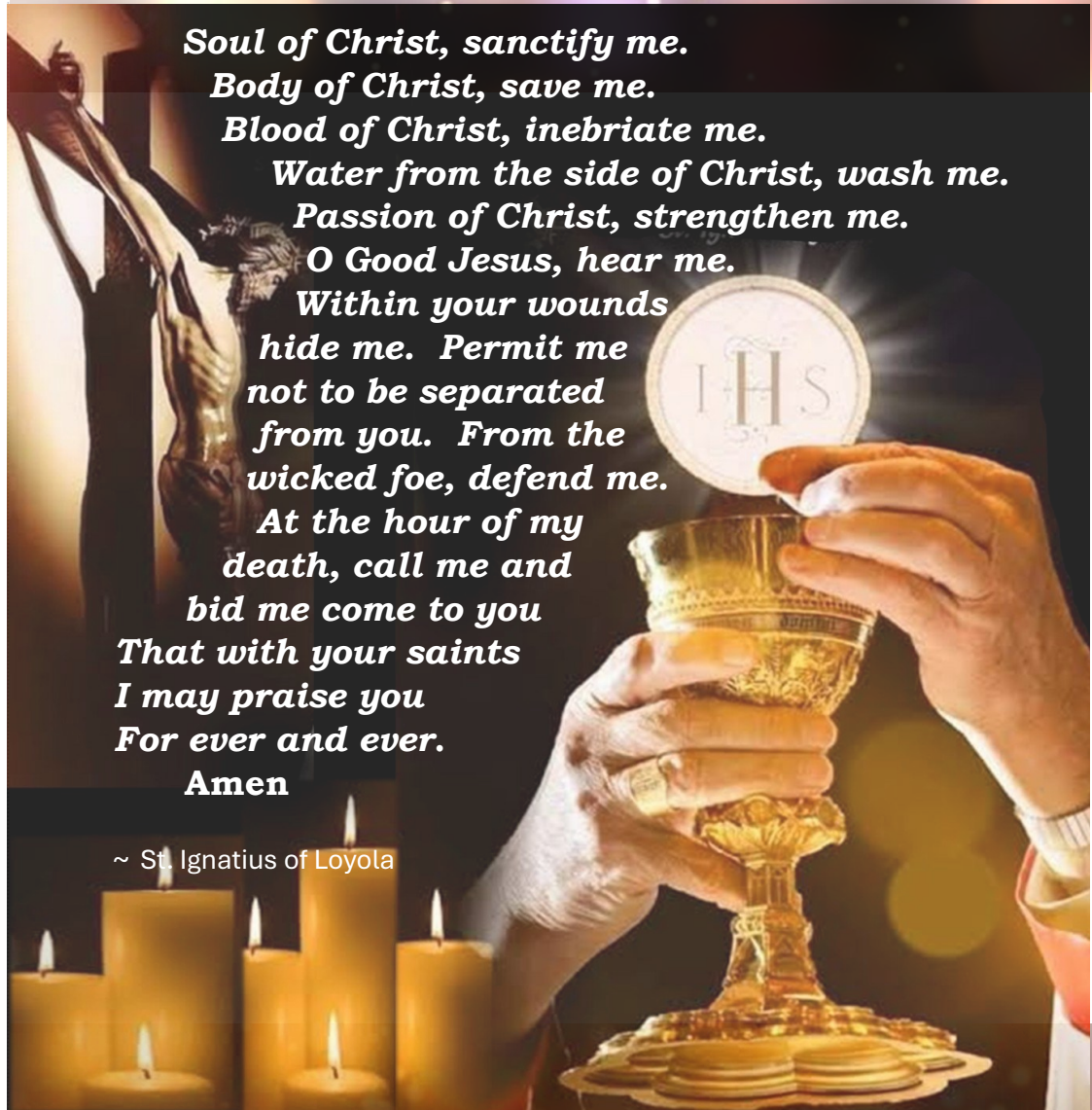

Excerpt from Pontifical Mission Societies Commentary

Corpus Christi Sunday – June 7, 2026

“The feast of Corpus Christi invites us to renew each year the wonder and joy of this wondrous gift of the Lord which is the Eucharist,” so Pope Francis reminded us during the Angelus, in Saint Peter’s Square, Saturday, 23 June 2019. The Eucharist emerges as “a free gift of the Blessed Trinity,” just as Pope Benedict XVI called it in his Apostolic exhortation *Sacramentum Caritatis* precisely “on the Eucharist as the Source and Summit of the Church’s Life and Mission,” as stated in the title.

Returning to the Gospel account of the multiplication of bread, we note that Jesus’ mission was shared with the apostles. The latter, who were already collaborators of Jesus in the proclamation of the Kingdom and in the care of the sick, will also be called to cooperate in the miracle of bread at the end of that memorable day. In fact, when they wanted to send the crowd away to “find provisions”, “he said to them, ‘Give them some food yourselves.’”

As in the multiplication of bread, Jesus also involved his disciples in the Eucharistic Mystery with the explicit command to them: “Do this in memory of me.” Indeed, this recommendation is repeated twice in Saint Paul’s account of the institution of the Eucharist, both after the words on bread and after those on wine. With this in mind, St. Paul concluded his concise account with a precious observation on the action of proclaiming Christ that goes together with participation in the Eucharist: “For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes” (1Cor 11:26).

And here is a beautiful reflection by Benedict XVI regarding the Eucharist and the mission of the community of the faithful: The love that we celebrate in the sacrament [of Eucharist] is not something we can keep to ourselves. By its very nature it demands to be shared with all. What the world needs is God’s love; it needs to encounter Christ and to believe in him. The Eucharist is thus the source and summit not only of the Church’s life, but also of her mission: “an authentically eucharistic Church is a missionary Church.” (234) We too must be able to tell our brothers and sisters with conviction: “That which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us” (1 Jn 1:3). Truly, nothing is more beautiful than to know Christ and to make him known to others. The institution of the Eucharist, for that matter, anticipates the very heart of Jesus’ mission: he is the one sent by the Father for the redemption of the world (cf. Jn 3:16-17; Rom 8:32). At the Last Supper, Jesus entrusts to his disciples the sacrament which makes present his self-sacrifice for the salvation of us all, in obedience to the Father’s will. We cannot approach the eucharistic table without being drawn into the mission which, beginning in the very heart of God, is meant to reach all people. Missionary outreach is thus an essential part of the eucharistic form of the Christian life. (Sacramentum Caritatis 84).





Our group typically meets once a month on a Saturday morning. Come join us on **Saturday, June 13**, Good Shepherd Church, Fireside Room at **10AM**.

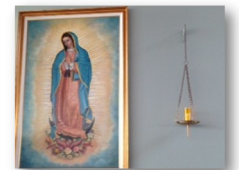

Come discover what it means to 'become Catholic' through a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly RCIA).

What does OCIA entail?

If you have NOT been baptized, the Christian initiation process prepares you to become a Catholic Christian by celebrating the sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

If you have been baptized in another Christian tradition, the initiation process prepares you to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church by celebrating the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.

I'm a baptized Catholic, is OCIA for me?

If you have been baptized as an infant, but have not received further formal instruction in the Catholic Faith nor the sacraments of Confirmation or the Eucharist, OCIA is indeed for you. If you are a fully initiated Catholic who wishes to deepen your faith, there is also a place for you to learn and grow.

How long does it take to become Catholic?

Becoming Catholic is a life-long commitment. However, the Christian initiation process typically lasts for several months or longer in order to prepare to take this step. Participants in the initiation process meet at least once a week, plus Mass on Sundays. The initiation of individuals who are ready to make the commitment to become new members of the Catholic Church usually takes place at Easter.

Baptism for (Young) Children: The baptism of your child is a very important opportunity for you, the parents, to reaffirm your Catholic faith. By asking for baptism, you are stating and affirming that you will actively participate in the spiritual life and Catholic faith development of your child. To help you prepare for your child's entrance into the sacramental life of the Church, **ALL parents and godparents** are required to complete **Baptism Preparation** prior to scheduling a Baptism. The **next Baptism Prep class is on Saturday, Aug. 15, 10am.** Register by contacting the parish office.

Baptism for Adults (and older teens): see OCIA

Confession: Weekly Confession times in our parish are 6:30pm Wednesdays and 10am Saturdays. Remember that Catholics aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance. (CCC 1415)

Marriage: Please contact the Parish Office for a meeting with Fr. Augustine at the beginning of your engagement or at least six months prior to your anticipated wedding date. All couples are required to take a marriage prep course; non-Catholics are most welcome, as are couples not yet engaged, but exploring marriage. Find out more at: rcav/marriage-prep or by emailing mprep@rcav.org

Are you a Catholic who Married outside the Church?

"Convalidation" in the Catholic Church offers a path to entering into a valid Catholic marriage when your previous ceremony was in the presence of ministers from other religious traditions or civil officials. It is not simply a "blessing" of an existing union, but rather, it requires that a new, free act of consent be made, bringing your marriage into full communion with the Church and allows couples to receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion and other sacraments. This process invites you to bring new meaning to your lives by embracing the vocation of marriage and dedicating your family's mission to sharing God's love. Please make an appointment with Fr. Augustine through the parish office to find out how to have your marriage "convalidated".

The Anointing of the Sick is offered to anyone who is in danger of death from an illness or from old age. The Catechism also states that it is appropriate to receive the Sacrament before having surgery. Anointing is offered for the possibility of spiritual and/or physical healing, and is not only for those who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, it is a fitting time for him/her to receive this sacrament (CCC 1514) Please call or email the parish office to make arrangements.
