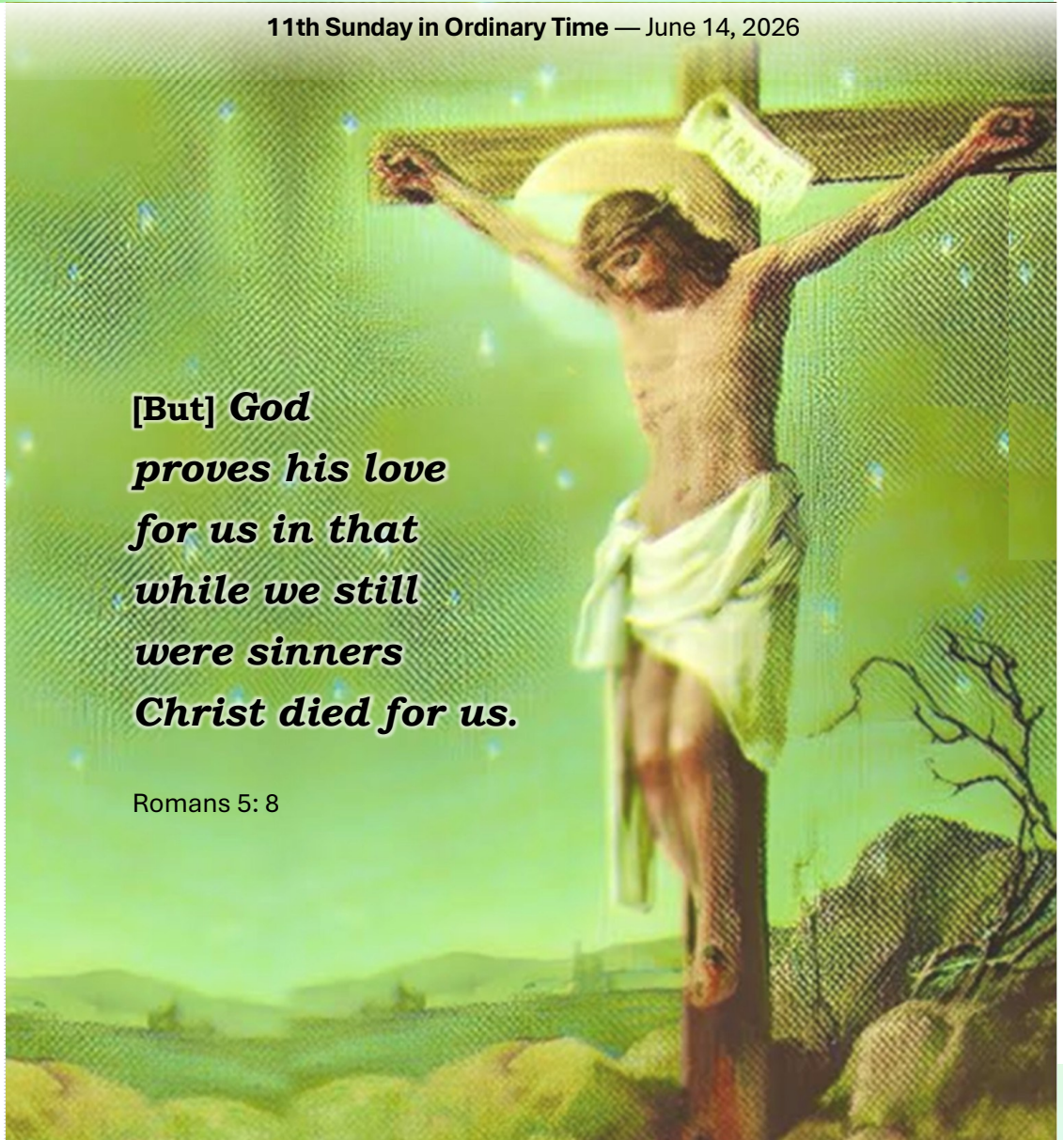

**A reflection on Matthew 9:36-38 from the Gospel for this 11<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time  
Matthew 9:36-10.8**

In the letter from Archbishop Smith read at the Masses last weekend, he announced a process of renewal for the Archdiocese of Vancouver. He encouraged us to “ask with a renewed faith: what does the Lord desire of his Church in Vancouver, and to what is he calling us?” The Archbishop shared that one of the areas of Archdiocesan life to consider how renewal should unfold is parish life.

Matthew 9:36-38 provides a short but powerful charter for the renewal of parish life. The Gospel begins with compassion: Jesus sees people as “sheep without a shepherd.” St. John Chrysostom reads this as part of Christ’s forethought in preparing the disciples for ministry. St. Thomas Aquinas then gives the practical consequence: when laborers are lacking, the Church must return to God in prayer, because the work of preaching is accomplished through prayer and the Lord himself is the one who sends the workers.

In that sense, Matthew 9:36-38 is not only a call to pray for more laborers; it is a summons for the whole parish to become the Lord’s laborers, moved by his compassion and ready for his harvest.

Matthew 9:38 has two movements: prayer and sending. First, disciples are told to ask the Lord of the harvest; mission is therefore God’s initiative. Second, the very term “laborers” implies active work in the field, not passive attendance. Chrysostom notes that Jesus, seeing the crowds with compassion, then directs the disciples toward this harvest, showing that missionary action flows from Christ’s own gaze and command.

The verse can be read as more than a prayer for “more clergy.” It is a prayer that God raise up true workers for his kingdom—people whose mission is ordered to God’s glory, not personal gain. Aquinas’s warning against “mercenaries” is especially important here: the harvest is God’s, so the laborers must belong to him in spirit and intention.

Vatican II teaches that the laity, by baptism, are made one body with Christ and are sharers in his priestly, prophetic, and kingly functions. The Council goes further: the lay apostolate is not optional. Through baptism and confirmation, all are “commissioned” to apostolate, and the laity are called to make the Church present in places where only through them can it become “the salt of the earth.” They are therefore “witness and living instrument” of the Church’s mission.

The Catechism makes the same point in practical terms. Lay people fulfill their prophetic mission through evangelization, and this evangelization has a “specific property and peculiar efficacy” precisely because it is carried out in ordinary circumstances of the world.

So, Matthew 9:38 supports the laity’s missional role because the “harvest” is not restricted to the sanctuary. The harvest field includes family life, workplaces, culture, education, social life, and parish life—exactly the places where the laity live and act by vocation. John Paul II says the lay faithful are called to work in the vineyard as part of the Church’s mission, and Pope Francis insists that evangelization cannot be left to professionals while the rest remain passive recipients.

For parish renewal, John Paul II explicitly says that the lay faithful are personally called by the Lord and that the present moment requires their active, conscientious, and responsible participation in the Church’s mission. Pope Francis likewise says that in virtue of baptism we become “missionary disciples” and that the People of God is both a disciple people and a missionary people.

A parish shaped by this Gospel will therefore form lay people for evangelization, catechesis, works of mercy, pastoral discernment, and public Christian witness. John Paul II describes parish renewal as including small living communities and greater participation by the laity in pastoral responsibilities, all in communion with pastors. That is a concrete way of answering Christ’s command in Matthew 9:38.

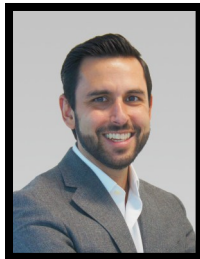

Come discover what it means to 'become Catholic' through a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly RCIA).

### **What does OCIA entail?**

**If you have NOT been baptized**, the Christian initiation process prepares you to become a Catholic Christian by celebrating the sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

**If you have been baptized in another Christian tradition**, the initiation process prepares you to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church by celebrating the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.

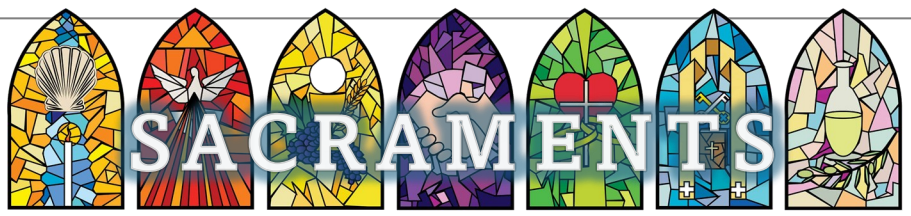
### **I'm a baptized Catholic, is OCIA for me?**

If you have been baptized as an infant, but have not received further formal instruction in the Catholic Faith nor the sacraments of Confirmation or the Eucharist, OCIA is indeed for you. If you are a fully initiated Catholic who wishes to deepen your faith, there is also a place for you to learn and grow.

### **How long does it take to become Catholic?**

Becoming Catholic is a life-long commitment. However, the Christian initiation process typically lasts for several months or longer in order to prepare to take this step. Participants in the initiation process meet at least once a week, plus Mass on Sundays. The initiation of individuals who are ready to make the commitment to become new members of the Catholic Church usually takes place at Easter.

**Baptism for (Young) Children:** The baptism of your child is a very important opportunity for you, the parents, to reaffirm your Catholic faith. By asking for baptism, you are stating and affirming that you will actively participate in the spiritual life and Catholic faith development of your child. To help you prepare for your child's entrance into the sacramental life of the Church, **ALL parents and godparents** are required to complete **Baptism Preparation** prior to scheduling a Baptism. The **next Baptism Prep class is on Saturday, Aug. 15, 10am.** Register by contacting the parish office.

**Baptism for Adults (and older teens):** see OCIA

**Confession:** Weekly Confession times in our parish are 6:30pm Wednesdays and 10am Saturdays. Remember that Catholics aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance. (CCC 1415)

**Marriage:** Please contact the Parish Office for a meeting with Fr. Augustine at the beginning of your engagement or at least six months prior to your anticipated wedding date. All couples are required to take a marriage prep course; non-Catholics are most welcome, as are couples not yet engaged, but exploring marriage. ### **Are you a Catholic who Married outside the Church?**

"Convalidation" in the Catholic Church offers a path to entering into a valid Catholic marriage when your previous ceremony was in the presence of ministers from other religious traditions or civil officials. It is not simply a "blessing" of an existing union, but rather, it requires that a new, free act of consent be made, bringing your marriage into full communion with the Church and allows couples to receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion and other sacraments. This process invites you to bring new meaning to your lives by embracing the vocation of marriage and dedicating your family's mission to sharing God's love. Please make an appointment with Fr. Augustine through the parish office to find out how to have your marriage "convalidated".

**The Anointing of the Sick** is offered to anyone who is in danger of death from an illness or from old age. The Catechism also states that it is appropriate to receive the Sacrament before having surgery. Anointing is offered for the possibility of spiritual and/or physical healing, and is not only for those who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, it is a fitting time for him/her to receive this sacrament (CCC 1514) Please call or email the parish office to make arrangements.
