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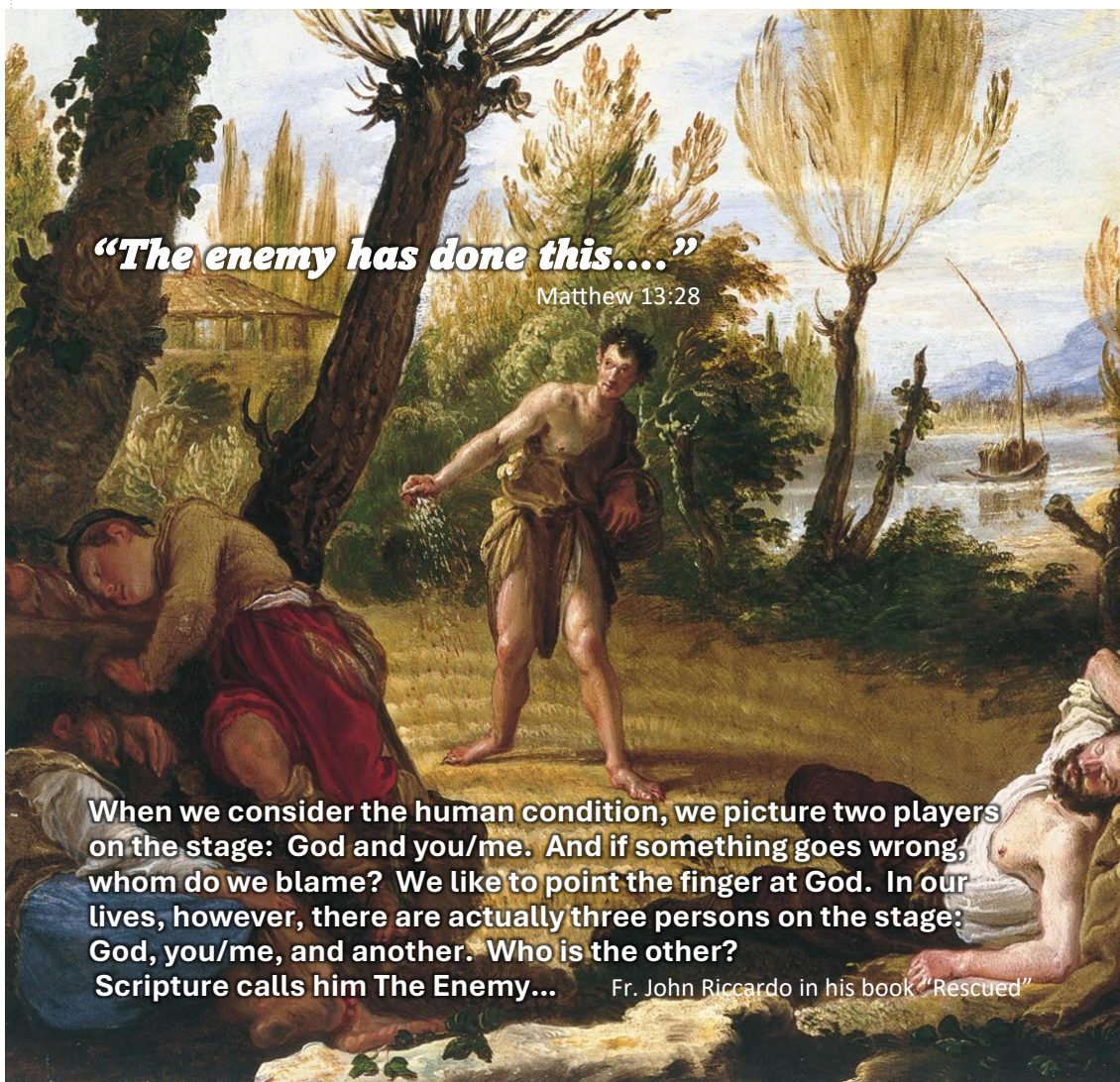

Dear Friends, Fr. Augustine has graciously given me permission to write an article for the bulletin for the weeks while he is away this summer. For this first article, perhaps I'll share with you a bit of what the OCIA inquirers will be hearing for our first few sessions together, in the hopes of piquing your interest and inspiring hope in you.

This coming Tuesday's session will be an introduction to The Kerygma. 'Kerygma' is a Greek word that means "proclamation". In the Catholic context, it is the core message of the Gospel—the Good News of Jesus Christ. Maybe for those who have grown up in the Church, like I did, we may think we are all too familiar with these fundamental truths. But my conviction is that you and I should never get tired of returning to the fundamentals – to core principles on which everything else is built. The world depends on us to be thoughtful about, and to stick to, and to be deeply versed in these core principles and fundamental truths. The other reason it's important to return to them time and time again is because these fundamental truths are increasingly challenged in our culture today... and so we need to be vigilant and aware if we want to be of use to Christ in our own time.

So if you're reading this and you yourself are unsure what this *Good News* is, I invite you to come and hear. Without it, our faith becomes yet another behaviour-modification program and a world already over-saturated with self-help programs!

Last week, I was in a conversation over drinks (i.e. casual and not that serious) with a few friends. I started talking about something spiritual and one of my friends quipped "Everything is about God to you!! You should stop worrying about what God thinks and just enjoy your life!" She's a good friend, and probably didn't mean anything by it... but what she said did start me thinking:

Some years ago, there was a slogan that started appearing all over the city of London – it was on billboards and on sides of busses, and it read: *There's probably no God so stop worrying and enjoy your life.* Everyone saw it—people passing by, walking and going about their daily lives, they read it everywhere. But take a moment to think about the hearts about some of those people who would have read those words. Because London, like all of the large cities of the world are full of parents whose children are sick and dying, people who have family members or who are they themselves suffering from an incurable disease, desperately lonely people who have been kicked to the curb by life, who have lost all hope and have nowhere to go, people whose families are torn apart by unforgiveness and disappointment, people who are in the grips of cruel addictions, the unemployed and destitute, refugees from warzones and people who are victims of a life of abuse or of terrible injustice. Imagine those people reading those words: *ENJOY YOUR LIFE.*

When you think about it that way, it is very clear that atheism is a luxury that only privileged people can afford - people who have all of life handed to them on a silver platter. Both formal atheism (a philosophical rejection of the possibility of the existence of God) *and* practical atheism (perhaps God exists, but even if he does, it doesn't matter and we can live as though he doesn't exist) are visions of life that are inadequate to reality, because they don't take into account the complexities of human life.

They don't account for the joys and the sorrows, the sufferings and the hopes and tragedies of human life.

Maybe you don't think you're suffering at all – things are pretty good you say! Well, maybe your life is relatively unafflicted by the great big sorrows and tragedies of life, even if an immediate member of your family didn't die yesterday or you didn't lose your job or you're not struggling with some sort of

“Becoming Catholic”

Tuesdays

Come discover what it means to ‘become Catholic’ through a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly RCIA).

What does OCIA entail?

If you have NOT been baptized, the Christian initiation process prepares you to become a Catholic Christian by celebrating the sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

If you have been baptized in another Christian tradition, the initiation process prepares you to enter into full communion with the Catholic Church by celebrating the sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion.

I’m a baptized Catholic, is OCIA for me? If you have been baptized as an infant, but have not received further formal instruction in the Catholic Faith nor the sacraments of Confirmation or the Eucharist, OCIA is indeed for you. If you are a fully initiated Catholic who wishes to deepen your faith, there is also a place for you to learn and grow.

How long does it take to become Catholic? Becoming Catholic is a life-long commitment. However, the Christian initiation process typically lasts for several months or longer in order to prepare to take this step. Participants in the initiation process meet at least once a week, plus Mass on Sundays. The initiation of individuals who are ready to make the commitment to become new members of the Catholic Church usually takes place at Easter. For more info, contact Janice:

In our modern era though, this vision of human life has been forgotten.... or maybe it’s more accurate to say that over the course of 300 years, it has been systematically rejected or set aside.

This powerful vision of life that I am speaking of, *does* take into account the tragedy and the joy, the suffering and the triumph of human life. And it is the vision that has been taught, guarded and passed down through the ages by the Catholic Church.

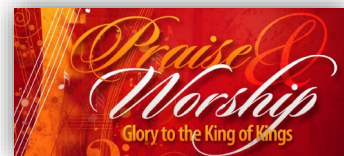

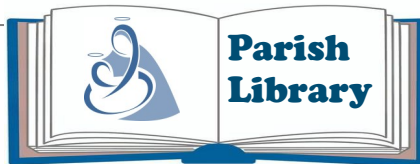

Protecting Our Children and Vulnerable Adults

We are in the process of updating our **Safe Environment Policies**, ensuring that our parish adheres to the thorough process for volunteer screening and strict guidelines for reporting abuse as set out by our Archdiocese. These policies require all clergy, employees, and volunteers in high-risk roles to pass a BC Criminal Record Check (CRC) with a Vulnerable Sector and receive proper Safe Environment Training. High-risk roles include:

- anyone in children's ministries
- anyone in contact with those who are susceptible to abuse or exploitation by virtue of his/her mental or physical impairment
- anyone visiting the homebound/hospitalized

If you have received an email requesting that you obtain a CRC,

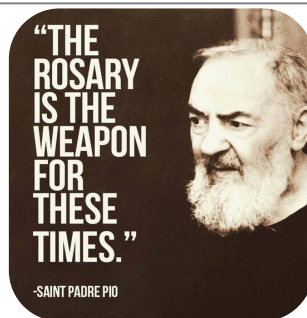


Book Sale Donations

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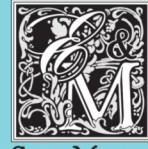
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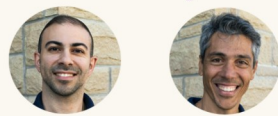
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
