

# What is Prayerful Giving?

Prayerful giving is a spiritual examination

of your financial commitment to our Church community, your spiritual home. Jesus, during his ministry on earth, continually taught that everything we have is a result of God's blessings upon us and that we are to willingly share of our blessings.

### Where Does the Money Go?

Each parish in the Archdiocese of Vancouver is self-funded. This means we need to pay our own lighting and heating bill, our own staff salaries, our dues to support the Archdiocese and payments on our debts.

Sharing our monetary blessings with our church is very important.

If Star of the Sea Parish is to continue to offer and expand the many ministerial activities that serve the needs of our community, everyone needs to be generous, consistent and dedicated in their financial support. And just as your own mortgage or rent payments still come due even when you are on holidays, all the bills for operating the parish must be paid every week or the year, even if you are away that week.



How Do I Know What is Enough?

Everyone must prayerfully consider his or her own financial commitment to Star of the Sea Parish. Are you giving according to God's will for you? Ask God! God knows your needs and what you can afford to give.

## But Are There Guidelines to Help Me Think About It?

In many Christian churches, parishioners are expected to tithe, that is to give 10% of their family income to the Church. If any of our parishioners make the decision to tithe, they will certainly be blessed in their giving, but we are not asking for 10% of your income in donations.

#### Can You Give Me an Example?

After much careful consideration, the Finance Committee of Star of the Sea Parish asks that each parishioner consider sanctifying their work by dedicating one hour of work per week to our parish community. This means each person who is able to do so should strive to set aside one hour's wage per week as a suggested weekly donation. This is roughly equivalent to 2.5% of a 40-hour work week.

Examples of Dedicating One Hour per Week (roughly equivalent to 2.5%)

2.5% of ANNUAL INCOME	MONTHLY CONTRIBUTION

Remember that God doesn't demand a fixed amount of money from us; He wants us to give from the heart, freely and cheerfully (1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Corinthians 9:5-8). It is not the amount of your donation so much as the spirit of engagement and participation in giving, as you contribute to the important work of our Parish and the Church.

# How Do I Get An Income Tax Receipt?

It is important that you register with the Parish in order to receive an income tax receipt. When you register, you will be asked if you wish to have envelopes or if you wish to sign up for our automatic bank withdrawal program—the Pre-Authorized Offering Plan (POP). Choose the method which is best for you and your family.

The Parish Office will keep track of your donations throughout the year. Receipts are issued in February each year for the previous year's donations.
